

ORDINANCE 89-9
AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 87-10

This Ordinance 89- amends City Ordinance 87-10 passed by Council May 4, 1987 to include Section 1 Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated known as the "Dangerous Dog Control Law".

Mended Code Section 4-8-21 shall read:

1. "Dangerous Dog" means any dog that, according to the records of an appropriate Authority:
 - (a) Inflicts a severe injury on a human being without provocation on public or private property at anytime after March 31, 1989.
 - (b) Aggressively bites, attacks, or endangers the safety of humans without provocation after the dog has been classified as a potentially dangerous dog and after the owner has been notified of such classification.

6. "Potentially Dangerous Dog" means any dog without provocation bites a human being on public or private property at any time after March 31, 1989.

Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 are amended to cover responsibilities of the dog owner, Dog Control Officer to the fullest extend of the law.

This amendment to Ordinance 87-10 shall further enforce all provisions and sections of the "Dangerous Dog Control Act" and shall not alleviate or diminish any previous sections 87-10.
